Nature of Claim: The nature of the claim is for severe and permanent personal injuries sustained by claimant, MARK WEYGANT, and all other damages allowed by statute and case law as a result of the negligence, carelessness, recklessness and gross negligence of COUNTY OF ULSTER, ULSTER COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, CITY OF KINGSTON DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, THE CITY OF KINGSTON and CATSKILL MOUNTAIN RAILROAD, its agents, servants and/or employees, departments, agencies and those acting under their directions, behest, permission and control in the ownership, operation, management, control and supervision of a certain sidewalk/railway located along the eastern portion of Washington Avenue at or near its intersection with Patroon Lane, Town of Kingston, County of Ulster and State of New York (see photographs annexed hereto and incorporated herein showing approximate location of the accident). Respondents, jointly and severally were negligent in failing to properly inspect, maintain, operate, repair, control and supervise the sidewalk/railway upon which Mr. Weygant was injured; in permitting the sidewalk/railway to be, become and remain in a broken, misleveled, pot-holed, unsafe, dangerous, defective and hazardous condition; in causing and permitting hazards and risks to exist which brought about the accident herein; in causing and creating a dangerous, hazardous and defective sidewalk/railway; in failing to highlight the existence and location of the hazard; in forcing Mr. Weygant into a position of danger; in failing to make timely inspections of the condition of the sidewalk/railway before the accident; in creating a trap and nuisance on the sidewalk/railway; in causing and permitting a trap and a nuisance to exist, in failing to warn those who were traversing said sidewalk/railway, and claimant herein specifically, as to the hazardous and dangerous condition; in violating Department of Transportation Highway Rules and Regulations; in failing to insure that appropriate warnings of the hazardous conditions were transmitted to the public by radio, internet and other channels of communications; in improperly designing the roadway; in permitting dangerous material(s) to be applied to make up the composition of the sidewalk/railway which caused the sidewalk/railway to become more dangerous; in failing to properly maintain the sidewalk/railway and in otherwise being careless, reckless and negligent under all of the attendant circumstances. Upon information and belief, respondents had prior notice of the said dangerous and defective conditions in that the conditions existed for such a period of time prior to the happening of the within accident, that the respondent's, its agents, servants and or employees, in the exercise of reasonable care and due diligence. knew or should have known that the condition(s) existed thereat and that respondents, its agents, servants and/or employees caused and created said dangerous and hazardous conditions. As a result of the negligence, carelessness and recklessness of the Respondents, their agents, servants and/or employees, departments, agencies and those acting under their directions, behest, permission and control Mr. Weygant suffered serious injuries.

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3. The time when, the place where and the manner in which the claim arose: Said claim arose on January 18, 2021, at approximately 09:50 a.m. while Claimant, MARK WEYGANT, who was a lawful pedestrian along Washington Avenue at or near its intersection with Patroon Lane, City of Kingston, County of Ulster and State of New York was traveling northbound along Washington Avenue when he was caused to trip and fall due to a raised, cracked broken, dangerous, and defective sidewalk/railway located thereat. Claimant lost control of his balance and was violently precipitated to the ground.

Claimant, MARK WEYGANT, sustained severe permanent personal injuries, including but not limited to a focal tear of the anterior talofibular ligament of the right ankle and other as yet undetermined injuries, the full extent of which are as yet not fully known. Claims are being made for personal injuries, hospital, physician and other medical expenses, pain and suffering, loss of quality and/or enjoyment of life, and all other damages to which claimants is entitled to by case law and statute.

As a result of the foregoing, claimant has been damaged in a sum of money commensurate with her injuries, which exceeds the jurisdiction of all lower Courts, together with the costs and disbursements of this action.




