RE: Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) Upgrades

Dear President Shaut:

A design project has been underway since 2018 to design extensive improvements at the WWTP. The primary purpose of the project is to bring treated effluent into compliance with permit limits imposed by the NYSDEC in 2016. The permit imposed lowered ammonia concentration limits on the effluent in order to protect water quality in the Rondout Creek.

In 2018, a resolution approved bonding in the amount \$1,200,000 for the design phase of the project. Also at that time, at EFC grant (WIIA grant 5374-08-00) was awarded to the city that will offset up to \$1,975,000 of the project cost. However, certain items are needed in order to finalize the finance agreement with EFC relative to this and to allow reimbursement of the City's costs by the grant. Further, we expect to qualify for no-interest financing of the City's share of the project cost which are not reimbursed by grants.

At this time, I am requesting the Common Council declare intent to be SEQR lead agency to allow us to begin a coordinated review. The project as designed is expected to be a Type 1 action under SEQR. Following the coordinated review (30-day period), I plan to return to council to request a resolution that will finalize the City's obligations under SEQR.

I plan to attend the meeting of the committee so that I may answer any questions that arise.

WHEREAS, the City intends to construct certain improvements at the wastewater treatment plant, including replacement of the outfall to the Rondout Creek, and

WHEREAS, the project is expected to be a Type 1 action under SEQR (6 CRR NY 617) and a Full Environmental Assessment form, dated July 19, 2021 has been prepared summarizing the project impacts, and

WHEREAS, the City intends to seek lead agency status under SEQR and to conduct a coordinated review of the interested agencies for the purpose of making a determination of the environmental impact and significance of the project
