Nina wrote this to you regarding the Fair St parking situation at our office building on the corner of (111) Maiden Lane & Fair St:

We measured the block on Wall St & it narrows toward Pearl St, but at Maiden Lane it's a full 37ft wide. The same as the previous block between St James & Maiden.

We also noticed that the Wall St block from Pearl St to Main St is the reverse, as it is narrow at Pearl St & widens at Main St, where there is parking on both sides.

We'd like to request at least 2 spaces, preferably handicapped, on our side of Wall St next to the fire hydrant on the corner.

We do like your suggestion of asking the new owners of the Catholic School parking lot for access. Although, because of the distance, we're thinking that if our staff can park there, that could help free up some spaces near the office. We look forward to working with on this project, thank you.
