Please accept this message as a communication to be placed on the agenda of the appropriate committee. I am requesting an amendment to Resolution 24 of 2025 in which NO PARKING signs were added to Merilina Avenue between Voorhees Avenue and Boulder Avenue.

The original intention was to limit the time for no parking on the street to the times of school drop-offs and pick-ups, but the committee report erroneously indicated NO PARKING on both sides of the street without the added time limitations. After discussion with Merilina residents and City staff, I am asking for the language of the Resolution to be amended to reflect the language on the signs that are currently installed between Voorhees Avenue and the Edson School, which read: NO PARKING OR STANDING, MON-FRI, 7AM-4PM.
