RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KINGSTON, NEW YORK RECOMMENDING NINE MEMBERS FOR APPOINTMENT BY THE COMMISSIONER OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY RENEWAL TO THE CITY OF KINGSTON RENT GUIDELINES BOARD

WHEREAS, In Resolution 144 of 2022 the Kingston Common Council declared that a housing emergency exists in Kingston as set forth in the Emergency Tenant Protection Act (ETPA) and opted into the provisions of the ETPA for buildings containing six or more rental units completed prior to January 1, 1974;

WHEREAS, A Rent Guidelines Board shall be created to consistent of nine members appointed by the Commissioner of Housing and Community Renewal upon recommendation of the local legislative body;

WHEREAS, Such recommendation shall be made within thirty days after the first local declaration of an emergency;

WHEREAS, Recommendations shall include two member representative of tenants, two representatives of owners of property, and five public members each of whom shall have had at least five years experience in either finance, economics, or housing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KINGSTON, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Kingston Common Council recommends the annexed nine members for appointment to the City of Kingston Rent Guidelines Board by the Commissioner of Housing and Community Renewal.

SECTION 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately.
