Hi Jeffrey, we would like to request a handicapped parking sign on Fairview Ave in front of building 8 apt#2. My dad moved there yesterday and Fairview Gardens can only provide him with a handicap parking spot down behind the next unit and about a quarter mile walk. He is 90 years old, a veteran and a retired Kingston city school physical education teacher. He wants to remain active but his orthopedic surgeon wants him to walk with a walker as his knee replacement is wearing out and inoperable. His old rental was going up for sale and with the housing shortage it was difficult to find him a place to live that was affordable and safe. His new apartment was recently renovated to be handicap accessible for someone in a wheelchair. Unfortunately there was no close parking and the only downstairs apartment they had. I noticed the other unit that faces Fairview has a few on street parking spots but the sign in front of his apartment says "no parking this side of street". I have enclosed a copy of his parking permit. Any assistance in this matter from the City of Kingston would be greatly appreciated.
