A/C	\$35 curbside or \$25 at Transfer Station
Area Rug	Brown Tote if it fits or \$.15 per pound at Transfer Station; MAX TOTE WEIGHT 50 lbs
Basketball Hoop	\$.15 per pound at Transfer Station or disassemble and separate according to material curbside
Bed Frame	NON-METAL: \$25 curbside or \$15 at Transfer Station; METAL: Call DPW Dispatch at 845-338-2114 to schedule free metal pick up (collections take place last Friday of each month)
Biodegradable Packing Peanuts	Bagged in Brown Tote or Home Compost
Books	Soft cover- Yellow Lidded Tote; Hard Cover- remove cover, cover in Brown Tote, pages in Yellow Lidded Tote
Bricks/Concrete	UCRRA at 845-336-0600
Car Oil	UCRRA Household Hazardous Waste collection; see www.ucrra.org
Carpet	Brown Tote if it fits or \$.15 per pound at Transfer Station
Ceiling Fan	Brown Tote if it fits or \$.15 per pound at Transfer Station
Christmas Tree/Wreath	Christmas Tree: Remove all decorations, wires, metal, and plastic. Place curbside January only Place Wreaths in Brown Tote
Construction Debris	UCRRA at 845-336-0600
Couch	\$25 curbside or \$15 at Transfer Station. Fee is PER SECTION If Sofa Sleeper, contact DPW Dispatch at 845-338-2114. Remove metal, call Dispatch for metal collection and \$25 curbside permit for couch collection
Dehumidifier	\$35 curbside or \$25 at Transfer Station
Electronics- TV/Monitor/Computer	\$15 Curbside or Free if brought to Transfer Station See Electronics Recycling list for full list of accepted e-waste.
Fence Panels	Brown Tote if it fits or \$.15 per pound at Transfer Station; MAX TOTE WEIGHT 50 lbs.
Fluorescent Bulbs	UCRRA at 845-336-0600
Food Containers	See Recycling Flyer
Furniture	Call DPW Dispatch at 845-338-2114 as policy varies by type

Hot Water Heater	Free at Transfer Station

Mattress/Futon Mattress/ Box Spring	\$25/piece curbside or \$15/piece at Transfer Station
Microwave	Free at Transfer Station or Call DPW for free curbside collection appointment 845-338-2114; Remove glass tray and place in Brown Tote
Mirrors & Light Bulbs	Brown Tote
Paint Cans	Latex- empty and dried in Brown Tote Oil Based- UCRRA Household Hazardous Waste Collection, call 845-336-0600
Pallets	Brown Tote if it fits or \$.15 per pound at Transfer Station; MAX TOTE WEIGHT 50 lbs.
Plastic Cups, Bowls, Plates	Brown Tote
Propane Tank	Small camping size- UCRRA Household Hazardous Waste Collection; Large- return to vendor
Refrigerator	\$35 curbside or \$25 at Transfer Station; remove door, place side by side
Router	\$15 Curbside or Free if brought to Transfer Station See Electronics Recycling list for full list of accepted e-waste.
Scrap Metal	Free at Transfer Station or Call DPW for free curbside collection appointment 845-338-2114 or take to local scrap yard for recycling
Shredded Paper	Bagged in Brown Tote; MAX TOTE WEIGHT 50 lbs.
Small Recycle Bin	Brown Tote; MAX TOTE WEIGHT 50 lbs.
Small Vacuum	Brown Tote; MAX TOTE WEIGHT 50 lbs.
Styrofoam	Brown Tote; MAX TOTE WEIGHT 50 lbs.
Table	\$25 curbside or \$15 at Transfer Station
TV	\$15 Curbside or Free if brought to Transfer Station See Electronics Recycling list for full list of accepted e-waste.
Tires	Fee for curbside collection, call DPW 845-338-2114 or bring to Transfer Station for a Fee; see Fee Schedule for details
Toaster/Blender/Coffee Maker	Brown Tote
Toilet/Sink	\$.15 per pound at Transfer Station

Trash Bins	Brown tote or \$.15 per pound at Transfer Station
Wood	Lumber: UCRRA at 845-336-0600 or \$.15 per pound at Transfer Station
	Wood furniture/shelves: Brown Tote if it fits or \$.15 per pound at Transfer Station or \$25 curbside per piece of furniture
	<p>Natural wood (tree limbs, branches):</p> <p>Tree prunings, shrubs and large branches should be no longer than 4 feet in length and 3 inches in diameter, and bundled curbside.</p> <p>Small debris must be containerized or placed in leaf bags.</p> <p>Large wood will not be accepted curbside, bring to the Transfer Station.</p>
