Live Well Kingston's Chess "Playground"

The goal of this project is to create a multi-generational chess "playground" to encourage play for all ages. Two chess tables and four benches will be installed at TR Gallo Park. Programming for monthly chess meet-ups will be developed in spring 2020.

The Health & Wellness Department, Play Well, and Age Well Focus Teams of the Live Well Kingston Commission collaborated to apply for and win an AARP Livable Communities Challenge Grant of \$11,224.

We envision people of all ages coming together to play chess in the City of Kingston's public park.
