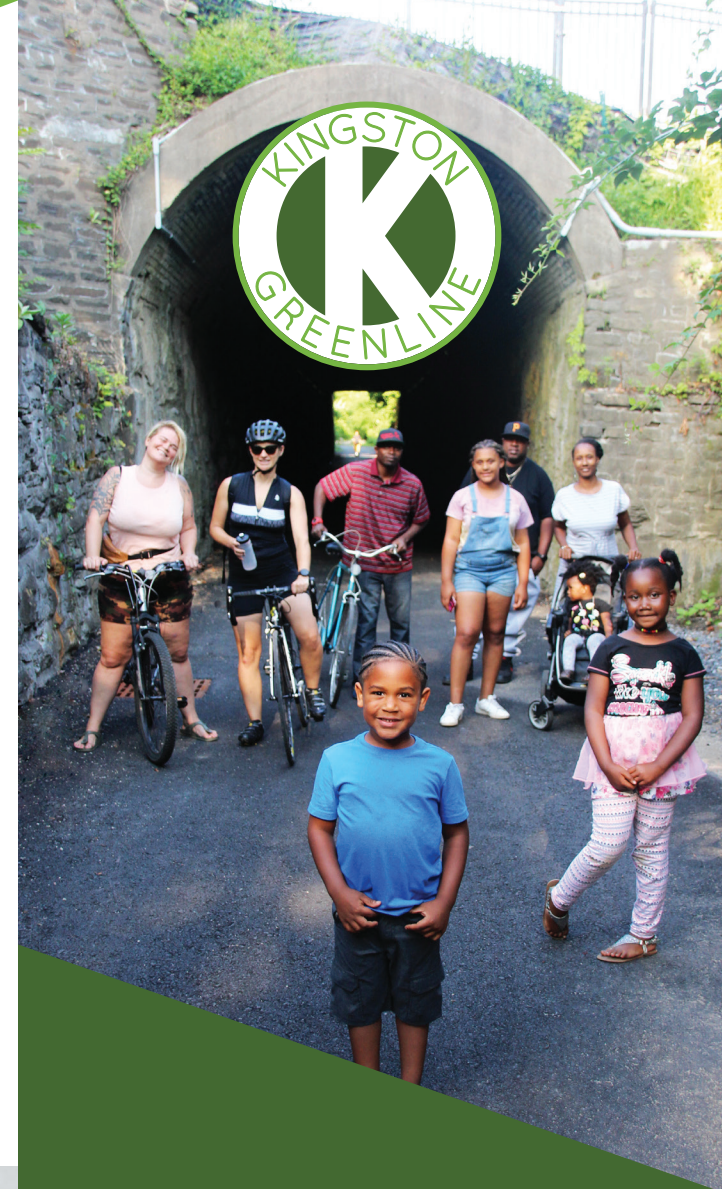


The Kingston Greenline is a
