



School Speed Zone Violation FAQ

What is a School Speed Zone Violation?

Under Chapter 390 of Part II, Article XIV of the Vehicle and Traffic Code of the City of Kingston, NY, if a vehicle is detected traveling at a speed over 10 mph over the posted limit, the Vehicle Owner shall be subject to a civil fine, as set forth in sections 390-204 and 390-206 of the Municipal Code of the City of Kingston.

Why have you received a School Speed Zone Violation?

You are the owner of a vehicle that was traveling **more than 10 mph over the speed limit** in a designated school zone **during school hours**.

Who can I discuss my School Speed Zone Violation with?

You can call the Citations Processing Center, Monday through Friday between 8:00am and 5:00pm at 1-833-965-3001.

How can I pay my School Speed Zone Violation? You can pay online, by mail, or by phone. Pay online: Visit www.trafficsafety citations.com. Visa, Discover, and MasterCard are accepted. A 4.5% convenience fee will be applied for all credit and debit card payments.
