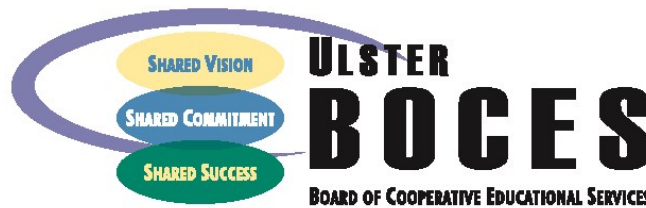
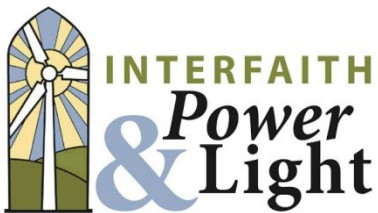

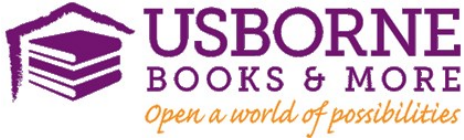

Electronics Recycling at Kingston Earth Fair 2018

Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency will be collecting e-waste for recycling all day on Saturday April 21st at the Earth Fair in Forsyth Park. This service is free.

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS FOR THE ELECTRONICS RECYCLING PROGRAM

- Computers (Desktops & Laptops)
- Computer Monitors (CRT, LED, LCD)
- In-Tact Computer Parts
- Printers (Ink & Toner)
- Ink/Toner Cartridges
- Televisions (CRT, LCD, LED, Plasma, 3D)
- Microwave Ovens (Non PCB)
- Copiers/Fax Machines
- Typewriters
- Telephones
- Cell Phones & Chargers
- GPS Units
- Pagers
- Tablets
- Answering Machines
- MP3 Players
- Scanners
- Radios/CD Players/Stereo Equipment, etc.
- Storage Devices (External Hard Drives, SD Cards, Memory Cards, Card Readers, etc.)
- Audio Equipment (Speakers, Microphones, DJ Equipment, Receivers, Recording Devices, Headphones, etc.)
- Video Equipment (Cameras, Video Cameras, Web Cams, Recording Devices, etc.)
- Communications Equipment
- Medical Testing Equipment
- Laboratory Equipment
- Circuit Boards
- Cables/Wires/ Power Cords/Power Strips/Routers, etc.
- Small Household Appliances (i.e. Microwaves, Blenders, Mixers, Coffee Makers)
- Business/Office Consumer Electronics
- Carbon Monoxide Detectors (Stand-Alone ONLY, Not Combined with Smoke Detector, Batteries Must be Removed)
- Vacuums (Bags must be removed and canisters emptied)
- Fans
- Christmas Lights

The Following Items are NOT Accepted for Electronic Recycling

- Anything Disassembled or Containing Broken Glass
- Freon Containing Devices/Appliances (Air Conditioners, Refrigerators, Freezers, Dehumidifiers)
- Materials/Devices Containing Liquids
- Yard/Lawn Equipment
- Gas Powered Equipment
- Lamps/Light bulbs
- Materials Leaking Fluid
- Radioactive Materials
- PCB Containing Materials
- Large Appliances (Washers, Dryers, Stoves, Dishwashers, etc.)
- Dry Cell Batteries (Alkaline, Nickel/Cadmium (NiCd), Nickel Metal Hydride (NiMH), and Lithium)
- Wet Cell Batteries
- Soda Streams
- Smoke detectors

Note: if you can't make the Earth Fair, you may drop off electronics for recycling from 8am to 3pm, Monday through Friday, except on holidays at UCRRA: 999 Flatbush Road in Kingston, NY.
