

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KINGSTON, NEW YORK, AUTHORIZING THE AMENDMENT OF THE CITY OF KINGSTON COMPLETE STREETS POLICY

WHEREAS, recommendation has been made on improving the effectiveness of the Complete Streets Advisory Council; and

WHEREAS, amending Resolution 196 of 2010 regarding the appointment structure is in the best interests of the Complete Streets Advisory Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KINGSTON, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section 6 of Resolution 196 of 2010 be amended to read as follows:


“That the Council is to be composed of nine (9) voting members appointed by the Mayor with approval by the Common Council who are interested in achieving Complete Streets and who want to explore opportunities and find collaborative access and streetscape solutions for pedestrians, cyclists, the elderly, young people, public transit users and people with disabilities. Representatives from each of the following will be encouraged: Conservation Advisory Council; Planning Board; Tree Commission; Historic Landmarks Preservation Commission; Board of Public Works; and the Human Rights Commission. There shall be eight (8) non-voting members, or their designees, consisting of the: City Planner; City Engineer; Office of Economic Development; DPW Director; Recreation Director; a representative of the county transportation planning organization and two (2) Aldermen.


The voting Council members will serve for two (2) year terms and vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment, except that a vacancy occurring other than by an expiration of term shall be filled only for the remainder of the unexpired term. Any person serving four (4) consecutive terms may, after a lapse of one (1) years, be eligible for re-appointment to the Council. This group will select a chair and form rules of procedure as they deem necessary and coordinate activities with other City staff and interested partners.”

SECTION-2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately.
