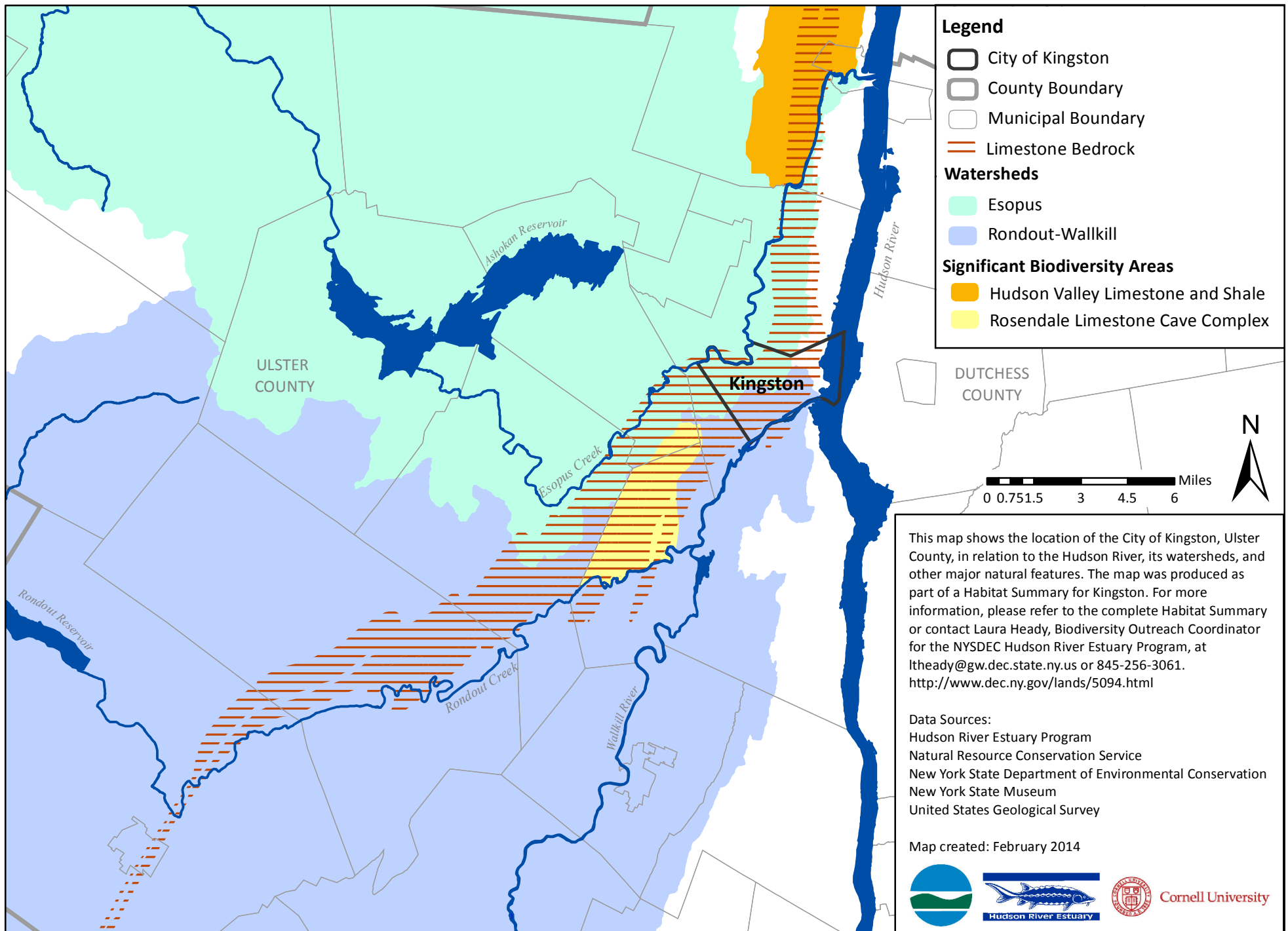


Figure 1: Regional Context of Kingston, NY
