Other Considerations


Technical: What kind of technical information will be needed to implement the policy?

Economic: What are the potential economic costs and benefits of implementation? How will implementation be funded?

Political: What stakeholders need to be involved and what stakeholders may object to the policy?

Social: Who may be adversely affected by a policy? How much long-term protection will the policy provide?
