

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KINGSTON, NEW YORK,
AUTHORIZING CREATION OF A CONSERVATION ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Article 12-F, Section 239-x of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York provides for the creation of a local conservation agency by any city, with said agency being considered as advisory in its relation to the local legislative body, the Common Council of the City of Kingston; recognizes and supports the need for such an agency in order to ensure the wise use of the City's natural resources and the enhancement and protection of its environment; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a commission for conservation of the environment is a necessary step in fostering unified action on environmental problems; and

WHEREAS, the creation of said Conservation Advisory Council would be in the best interests of the City of Kingston.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KINGSTON, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION-1. The Common Council of the City of Kingston authorizes the creation of a Conservation Advisory Council.

SECTION-2. Said Conservation Advisory Council is to consist of not less than five members, nor more than nine members, all of whom reside within the City of Kingston, each to serve a term of two years and who shall be appointed without compensation by the Mayor of the City of Kingston.


SECTION-3. Final approval for the creation of the Conservation Advisory Council is contingent upon research and opinion to be rendered by the Corporation Counsel's office of the City of Kingston.


SECTION-4. All policies are subject to Common Council approval.
